NEWS FROM THE CLASSROOM...

Kindergarten started diagraphs in Fundations and we are continuing to tap words out. In Math we have started a unit of study on measurement. We are learning new vocabulary. We also are learning how flowers grow, through stories, projects and short videos. We had a visit

from the Math coach to help with some hands on learning and centers for our classes.

math. We are looking forward to measuring some staff members hand prints and foot prints this week. We will use different nonstandard units of measurement to do this. In Fundations, we started reading and writing words with blends. We are also doing a great job identifying long a words in our new story in Journeys. In writing, we really enjoy writing "how to" paragraphs using the words; first, next, then, and last.

Second Grade students begin their Life Sciences unit by exploring different animal habitats. Students have also been researching ways to help protect the earth. Students wrote a paragraph persuading readers to do their part to help Save the Earth. Their writing will be displayed in the hallway bulletin boards. This week in Ms. Levine's class, students have been working hard on their animal

This week in Ms. Levine's class, students have been working hard on their animal research projects in wiring. Students are using EPIC! as well as National Geographics to find information about their chosen animal. In reading, students in iRead are reading either *Animals in Art* or *Rap A Tap Tap*. The System 44 group is working on Module 3- Friends or Foes? In Math students are working on double digit and triple digit addition and subtraction with and without regrouping and borrowing. Students are also working on one step word problems.



Third Graders has been learning about equivalent fractions and how to compare and order them. In writing, students have been continuing to practice answering questions about details in a text using the R.A.C.E Writing strategy. In this, students will restate the question, answer, cite evidence to support then answer, and explain their evidence and



response. Students cannot wait to go to the Philadelphia Zoo for their field trip this week! This is their first field trip since Kindergarten!

Fourth Graders

This week in Mrs. Milewski's ELA class students read a brochure text entitled, *Parasites and You*. Students worked with

partners to complete a "Think Pair Share" on how to prevent these parasitic diseas-



es. Students enjoyed the lesson and learned how to summarize a text. Students are writing their final drafts of their animal research papers. In math students are learning how to compare fractions with hands-on activities and fraction strips.

Fifth Graders are so excited to start their next novel study on <u>Daniel's Story</u>, by Carol Matas. They have enjoyed starting to learn the background of the Holo-

caust and look forward to learning more about it as we read. Students have just finished up their math unit on fractions and are glad to be



starting geometry...polygons, quadrilaterals, and triangles, oh my! In science we are learning about classifying living things and are using a dichotomous key to sort candy...we know it't not living, but we are having fun doing it anyway!


- Fill out the available forms online, being sure to select the 2022-2023 school year option.

HEALTH OFFICE

The State of New Jersey, Department of Health and Senior Services, has mandated that children born after January 1997 and entering 6th grade must receive a booster dose of Diphtheria, Pertussis and Tetanus (Tdap) and one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine. Documentation of having received these vaccines must be provided upon entry into 6th grade. If your child receives these immunizations during his/her 5th grade school year, please send documentation your child's school nurse.

If you have any questions regarding this requirement, please contact the health office at your child's school. Thank you in advance for your attention to this matter.

MINIMAL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IN NEW JERSEY

DISEASE(S)	MEETS IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS	COMMENTS
Tdap	GRADE 6 (or comparable age level for special education programs): 1 dose	For pupils entering Grade 6 on or after 9-1-08 and born on or after 1-1-97. A child does not need a Tdap dose until FIVE years after the last DTP/DtaP or Td dose.
MENINGOCOCCAL	Entering GRADE 6 (or comparable age level for Special Ed programs): 1 dose (1) (Entering a four- year college or University, previously unvaccinated and residing in a campus dormitory): 1 dose (2)	(1) For pupils entering Grade 6 on or after 9-1-08 and born on or after 1-1-97. (2) Previously unvaccinated students entering a four-year college or university after 9-1-04 and who reside in a campus dormitory, need 1 dose of meningococcal vaccine. Documentation of one prior dose is acceptable.
