PEKIN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

Any PCHS student that is requesting to bring a date who is not a Pekin Community High School student, must have this form completed and returned **3 days prior to the date of the dance (3 P.M. Wednesday, APRIL 27, 2022)**. Failure to return the form in the specified time will make the guest ineligible to attend the dance. Please notice that this form requires the signature of the principal or administrator of the guest's school. College students are not required to have this signature. **ALL GUESTS NEED TO PRESENT A CURRENT PHOTO/COLLEGE ID WITH THE GUEST PASS. If the guest is not currently attending a high school, he/she may have a telephone interview with a PCHS administrator prior to 3 P.M. Friday, APRIL 29, 2022.**

As a PCHS student, I understand that all PCHS rules apply at any school function. I am also aware that once my date and I leave the dance, we will not be allowed re-entry for any reason. I understand that neither my guest nor I may be in possession of, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol during this activity. The use and/or possession of tobacco products is not allowed at any school activity and is an ordinance violation for students under the age of 18 in the City of Pekin. I will take full responsibility to inform and ensure my date's compliance to all school rules while attending the dance. **The guest must have photo identification in his/her possession at all times.**

No guests age 21 or older will be allowed at the dance. In addition, junior high students will not be allowed at the dance. Drop-outs from any school will not be allowed at the dance. PCHS administration reserves the right to deny any guest.

- ★ **Return the Recommendation Form to the County Clerk's Office in the McKenzie Building on 4th St. in Pekin (Located next to the Courthouse).**
- ★ **Attend the Online Training**
- ★ **Be Prepared for a LONG day on June 28th. You are EXPECTED to be there the whole time Polls are Open!**

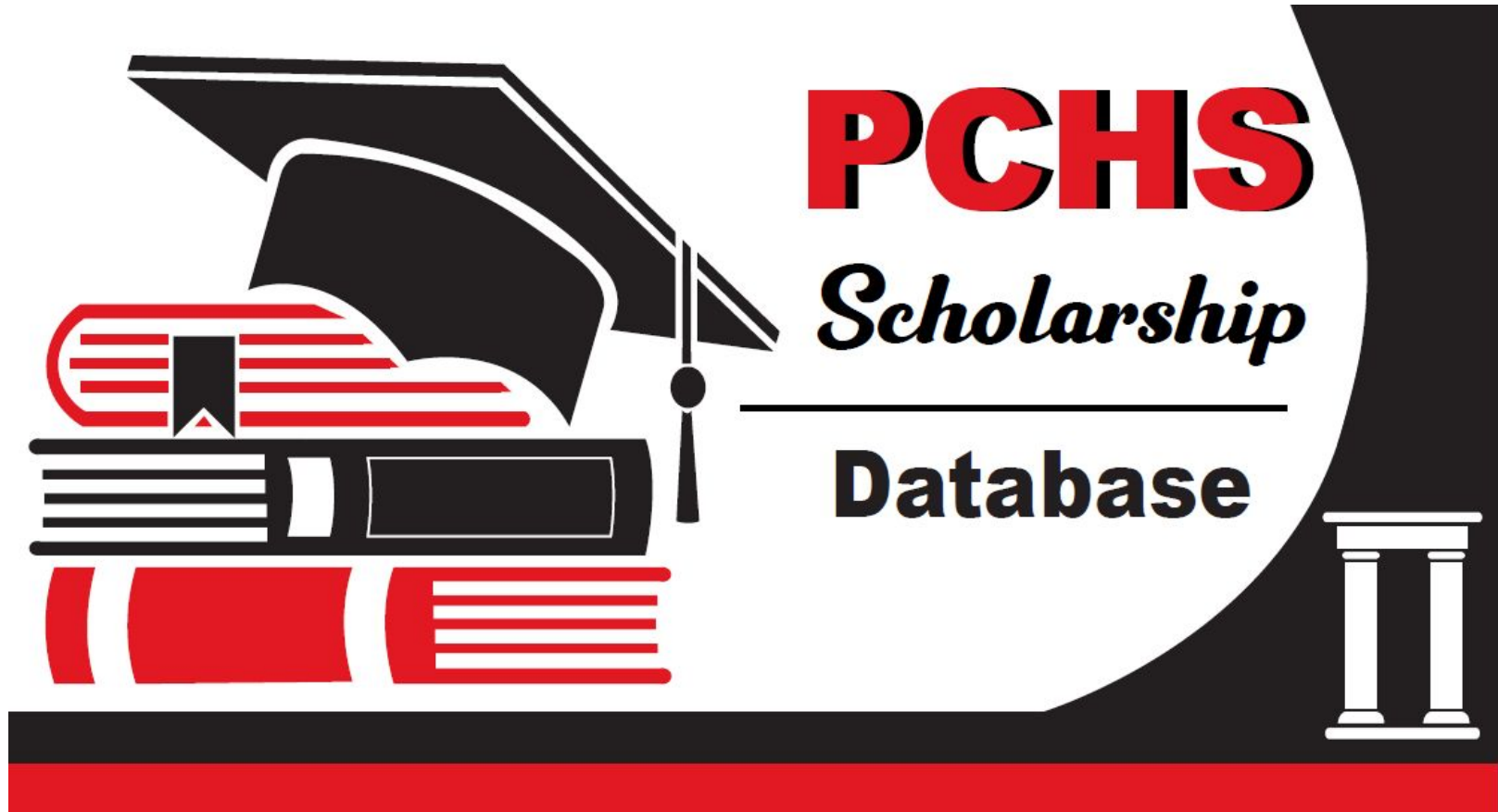
