Dear Franklin Families,

Fall is definitely in the air, and it is usually this time of year that students begin adjusting to their new classroom routines and teachers become more familiar with their students' abilities, needs, and likes. We are lucky at Franklin because positive classroom relationships tend to forge quickly.

Ask your child about Zones of Regulation, a new social/emotional program we have implemented this year to help students identify their feelings. Students can be in one of four color zones:

- BLUE "I may not be able to concentrate because I am sad, bored, or tired."
- GREEN "I am ready to learn!"
- YELLOW "I may not be able to focus because I am too excited, frustrated, or irritated!"
- RED "I am so angry, excited, or out of control, that learning is impossible."

Throughout the year, teachers will also teach strategies that students feel comfortable putting in their toolbox to use when needed. Parents are finding it helpful to use this language at home, too.

As we get into the colder months, please ensure that your child comes to school wearing the proper clothing. Jackets, socks, sneakers, and even hats will be necessary during these days of fall so students are comfortable playing outside at recess and during physical education.

I would like to sincerely thank all parents and caregivers who have given ample notice to the office for dismissals and/or gave us a phone call when your child was sick. Your simple actions make our days go much smoother.
