They will be assigned a virtual tutor and work with this trained instructor for the remainder of the school year. We are pleased Franklin was selected to pilot this DESE grant funded program.

We also welcome back Jay Mankita, our Playful Engineer, who will work with our second and third graders in understanding the workings of small machines and inspiring students to build their own creations. Through a MA Cultural STARS grant, Mr. Mankita will be a teacher in residence with us for eight days engaging our scholars in engineering practices.

We are so grateful that we are able to offer so many wonderful opportunities to all of our students. From before/after school programs to field trips. Many of these opportunities would not be possible without funding through grants and our PTO; most would not be possible without the dedication of our staff. We are so blessed with amazing educators.
