ATTENDANCE AUTOMATED CONTACT STARTING APRIL 11TH

Previously, the office staff members have attempted to make successful contact with a parent/guardian when the attendance office had not received proper notification that a student would be absent. Beginning on 4/11/22, Metuchen High School will be piloting the use of an automated process to contact parents. Now, the parent/guardian will receive contact via text, email, and phone call if they have not contacted the school to indicate that the student will be absent, with the gentle reminder to contact the school with the reason for the student's absence.

Please be sure to check the phone numbers you have listed in Genesis for Guardian 1 and Guardian 2, as these will be the numbers that will be used. Remember: you have the ability to revise your contact information, when necessary.

We will be monitoring and reviewing the system over the next few weeks to determine how to make appropriate adjustments. Thank you, in advance, for your patience and cooperation.

MHS JUNIOR-SENIOR PROM 2022

This year's prom is quickly approaching! The Junior/Senior Prom will be held at The Pines Manor in Edison, NJ on Thursday, May 26, 2022 from 6PM until 11:00PM. Prom bids will cost \$75.00 per student and the bids will be available to be purchased during lunches beginning on April 28th through May 12th. Checks should be made out to Metuchen High School and in the memo section please mark Class of 2022 Junior/Senior Prom.

If your child is attending the Prom with an outside guest (this includes MHS Alumni), a MHS Guest Form must be completed and approved before bids are purchased. MHS Guest Forms are available on the Metuchen High School website. You will be able to access the document by clicking on the 2022 Prom Tab located under the pictures on the Metuchen High School Main Page. Once completely filled out, the MHS Guest Form must be handed into the Main Office for approval. The deadline for handing in the MHS Guest Forms is Wednesday, April 27th. All forms MUST be approved by school administration before bids are purchased.

PROM 2022 EARLY DISMISSALS

Students must attend school on May 26th in order to attend the prom that evening. Students will not be dismissed prior to 1:00pm. To submit an early dismissal request for the prom, please log onto the Genesis Parent Portal and click on the "Forms" Tab. The 2022 Early Dismissal For Prom Form is located there. All early dismissal requests must be completed through the Genesis Parent Portal and must be submitted no later than the end of the school day on Tuesday, May 24th. Your child will need to sign out at the front door.
