## Release of District Responsibility Regarding NJSLA Testing

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) requires all students to take state assessments as scheduled and there is no provision for a student to opt out of state assessments. If a student is absent on a testing date, the student will be expected to take the missed test on another school day.

Madison Board of Education Policy #2622 - Pupil Assessment also requires the district to administer state assessments and outlines the importance for students to take the tests seriously. The policy notes that the data collected will be used "to pinpoint areas of difficulty and customize instruction accordingly. Such data can be accessed and utilized as a student progresses to successive school levels."

The district's position is that students who are eligible for testing should participate in testing and should work to the best of their ability to reach proficiency. This approach provides the district with a valid snapshot of our performance and allows us to reflect on areas of success and areas in which we can make improvements. This approach also ensures that we are complying with the appropriate regulations.
