# Operational Guidelines for 2021-2022

#### Masks

- Optional for students and staff.
- It is not optional in a school vehicle. Federal Law requires all staff and students to wear a mask while being transported in a school vehicle.
  - CDC Public Transportation Mandate (SD 1582/84-21-01A, https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/face-masks-public-transportation.html) masks on all public transportation which includes school buses and all school transportation. (we were informed about this mandate on 8/05/2021)

#### Quarantine

- Positive case isolates for 10 days
- Close contact of an in-school positive case will monitor for symptoms and can stay in school as long as they are not having symptons. (close contacts are considered with 3-feet of the positive case for more than ten minutes.)
- Close Contacts will be determined by the Ottawa County Health Department with the help of our school nurse.

#### Hygiene Measures

- Hand washing emphasis will continue
- Hand sanitizer will be available around the school
- STAY HOME WHEN FEELING ILL

#### Vaccinations to school communities

- USD 239 students and staff <u>will not be required to be vaccinated</u> for COVID-19 to attend school
- We will provide information of our local vaccination providers for those who request it.

#### Accommodation for Children with Disabilities

• Students with an IEP, 504 Plan, and other documented student supports will have all appropriate accommodations and supports made available to them.

#### Coordination with State and Local Officials

- We will meet regularly with officials on the latest data and inform all stakeholders as needed.
