**Whereas**, dispatchers have extensive classroom and hands on training. Most dispatchers have handled horrific incidents while maintaining total composure, demonstrating sharp critical thinking, and executing perfect multitasking ability; and

**Experses**, the members of the Public Safety Telecommunications of Old Bridge play an essential role in ensuring that everyone has the resources they need in times of emergencies. The communication centers receive calls from persons seeking immediate relief during an emergency as well as those seeking to report suspicious behaviors or unusual incidents; and
