Tinora High School Class of 2022 Graduation Information

Congratulations on your child's upcoming graduation! As a soon-to-be Tinora alumni, I would like to communicate expectations for commencement with you and your graduate. Formal events have formal expectations. Therefore, while we are excited to celebrate your individual accomplishment, please remember that graduation commencement celebrates nearly 95 individual accomplishments, collectively.

Attire for graduation commencement on June 5, 2022:

Girls - Light color dress (if possible), appropriate shoes (no tennis shoes)

Boys - Shirt, tie, dress pants (no jeans), dress shoes with socks

No extra decorations are allowed on caps and gowns.

The graduation ceremony is a school-sponsored activity, therefore, all school rules apply. **Graduates not in compliance with the school rules, and expectations listed above, will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.** All school obligations (fees, fines, books due, money owed, etc.) must be cleared by Friday, May 20. Any senior with credit deficiency, outstanding obligations (Tinora or Four County), or any other situation that would prevent graduation, will be notified before commencement. If the obligations have not been paid or rectified, he or she will not be allowed to participate in commencement.

Graduation practice is currently scheduled for the last student school day: **Thursday, June 2, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.**

Graduation practice is required. Those not in attendance will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony! Following practice, graduates will participate in the Senior Salute at Tinora Elementary School. Once the Senior Salute is completed, seniors will be dismissed for the remainder of the day. Graduation will be held on Sunday, June 5 at 2:00 p.m. in the Tinora Performing Arts Center. Students are expected to arrive by 1:00 p.m. on June 5th.

April 15: Baby Pictures

May 13: Tinora High School Awards Day

We will be holding our annual awards banquet on Friday, May 13, beginning at 9:00 a.m. in the high school gymnasium. Parents are welcome to attend!

May 31-June 2: Final Exams

If required to take a final exam, seniors MAY be given the opportunity to take their final exams on May 26 & 27, per teacher discretion. Students should communicate with their individual teachers about exam schedules. If required to take the exam during regularly scheduled exams (May 31-June 2), seniors may attend for the required period only.

Senior Yard Sign

Senior yard signs will be distributed at graduation practice on June 2. Each student will receive one yard sign.

May 27: Seniors' Last Day of School

The last scheduled day of school for seniors will be Friday, May 27. If all obligations are not met, seniors will be required to attend through the regularly scheduled last day of school on June 2.
