ARRIVAL

Early Arrival: 7:00-7:45

Student Drop Off: 25th St., Cafeteria entrance gate Route: Veterans to Mississippi take right on 25th St. Turning from Roosevelt illegal. Students must be registered with Community Works Before Care.

Lower School (1st-4th) & 5th-8th siblings

Arrival: 7:45-8:10 Student Drop Off: Maine Avenue Horseshoe

Route (see map):

1. Veterans to <u>Mississippi</u>, take a right on 26th Street. Get into the left hand lane <u>after</u> Massachusetts; take a left on Maine

2. From W. Napoleon take a left on <u>Mississippi</u>; left on 26th St. Get into the left hand lane <u>after</u> Massachusetts; take a left on Maine

Enter the parking lot horseshoe; pull all the way up and close to the car in front of you, and drop students from passenger door on signal. NO passing or cell phone use in carpool line.

Middle School (5th-8th) ONLY

Arrival: 7:45-8:20 Student Drop Off: 26th Street gate

Route (see map):

1. Veterans to Mississippi Street, take a right on 26th Street, get into the right hand lane <u>after</u> Massachusetts and proceed down 26th Street to the MS/HS building

2. From W. Napoleon, take a right on Westgate; left on Mississippi; left on 26th St., get into the right hand lane <u>after</u> Massachusetts and proceed down 26th street to the MS/HS building.

Pull close to car in front of you, and drop students at the 26th Street gate. NO passing or cell phone use in carpool line.

Tardy Students

1st – 4th grade - Tardy after **8:10**

 $5^{\text{th}}-8^{\text{th}}$ grade - Tardy after $\pmb{8:20}$

All students who arrive tardy must be checked in at the front office on Maine Avenue.

DISMISSAL

Lower School (1st-4th) & 5th-8th siblings Dismissal: 3:30 Dismissal from Maine Avenue Horseshoe (Vehicles may not enter horseshoe prior to 3 PM)

Have your <u>blue sign</u> with Student Last Name hanging from your rearview mirror.

Middle School (5th-8th) ONLY Dismissal: 3:30 Dismissal from 26th Street gate

Have your yellow sign with Student Last Name hanging from your rearview mirror.

All Carpool Drivers must have a 8 X 11 yellow or blue sign with the student last name hanging from the rearview mirror. Please pick up your signs on Family Science Day or the front office.


Students not picked up by 3:45 will be sent to Community Works After Care and a late pick up fee will be assessed which is to be paid by check or credit card at the time of pick up.

Bus Transportation:

Bus service limited to funnel more funding to classrooms and only available to Kenner residents. Bus service is contracted through F. Wells Transportation. Wells will contact all bus riders with routes. Bus pick-up/drop-off questions may be directed to Wells Transportation (504) 469-1277.

Walkers:

Walkers are defined as students who live in the immediate neighborhood (Please see map below.) and do not utilize motorized transportation as a means for arrival and dismissal. Walker verification must be approved by administration. Once verification is obtained, the students' names will be placed on the official walker's list. Only students who reside within the highlighted radius and are listed on the official walker's list will be dismissed from the walker's gate. Students will report to the nurse's hall or the cafeteria and will be dismissed from the walker's gate after the bus students are loaded and departed. Buses depart at approximately 3:45 pm.


