## **INSTRUCTION**

## Independent Study, K-12

Independent study may be offered as an alternative to a regular classroom program of instruction.

Independent study is open to students under one of the following conditions:

- 1. Students of legal school age residing in the Modesto City Schools District, but not enrolled in one of the District's schools.
- 2. Students enrolled in the Modesto City Schools District, but temporarily unable to attend classes.
- 3. Students enrolled in the Modesto City Schools District, but unable to register for specific classes or subjects for which they are qualified.
- 4. Students enrolled in the Modesto City Schools District and participating in an approved off-campus program not offered in the District or not offered at the level of proficiency commensurate with the students' interest or ability.
- 5. Students enrolled in the Modesto City Schools District in need of special remediation because of competency failure.
- 6. Students enrolled in the Modesto City Schools District in need of additional units or required courses for promotion or graduation as a result of previous failing grades.

The District reserves the right to prescribe a maximum number of units and courses earned through independent study for any one student.
