## KBA Status Update / Community Visioning Update / Discussion – Deep Dive Visioning

Presented virtually by Mr. Trim and Dr. Frank Locker

- Mr. Trim introduced Dr. Frank Locker, Educational Programmer/Planner working on all the Visioning for the project along with KBA and Cropper to the Committee
- Dr. Locker gave overview for structure of Master Planning workshops
  - Deep Dive Visioning Workshops should be day long in-person sessions with representatives from community as wells as school.
    - Possible dates during 2<sup>nd</sup> week of April 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> similar to how Middle School concepts were developed (three days)
    - Conversation with Stake Holders that focus groups should be made up of diverse cross section of community members (to be made up of students, parents, educators, business leaders, administration, community members, and elected officials) vs. anyone can attend as in Community Workshops
    - Effective number of people to ensure productive sessions (max 50); smaller group in order for dialogue to be effective.
    - Two-day commitment
    - Master Plan needs to serve District for next 50 years. Long term educational visioning, develop concepts that are flexible, focus on future facilities are going to be appropriate and effective
  - Community Workshop sessions to be held virtually (2-hour sessions)
    - April 4 (6:30-8:30pm) and April 5 (11am-1pm)
    - To be made accessible for anyone to attend; identical presentation for both session
    - Presentation by Dr. Locker then break out into smaller groups for open discussion, learning from them, parameters, concerns, boundaries, etc.
    - Information gathered from these smaller sessions will be used for structuring Deep-Dive sessions
    - Pre-register with name and address
    - Zoom breakout sessions in groups of 6-10 balanced with residence representing all parts of district, members of same family in different discussion groups with Committee members and KBA architects
    - Discussions will be recorded, score sheets with presentation
  - o Dr. Locker feels the format, with this approach committee is as accountable as can be to open opportunities to hear from community.
  - Outcome from Community Workshops and Deep-Dive sessions will guide the Master Plan architects and planners in developing Master Planning options for review by the School Building Committee, which will make a recommendation of the best options to the School Committee.
  - Ms. Bae asked committee members for their availability to be in breakout rooms

- Dr. Locker shared presentation from what he felt was a similar project in Shake Heights, OH
  - o Dr. Locker worked with Cropper on project; feels they will serve district well
