

# The ACT and You

**The ACT** test is considered your college entrance exam. Your score on this test is **one** of the factors that determines your acceptance at colleges and universities. It also is a factor in determining scholarships you might be eligible for. The state of Arizona administers this test to all Juniors. ACT Aspire is given to Freshman.

**You should** take the exam two or three times beginning late in your sophomore year. The first time the state requires is your Junior year. Seniors have the option of taking the test again in September or October if you want to improve your score. Scores from these test dates will be returned in time for college applications.

**Please prepare** for this test. Your future could depend on it. The test has four sections: English, Math, Reading, and Science Reasoning. There is also an optional Writing test. Buy and use a good prep program/book/online resources such as Getting into the ACT or come to an Enrichment prep. You need to **register online at [www.act.org](http://www.act.org)**. Registering will take a couple of hours.

**These test dates and registration deadlines have been confirmed by ACT. The score release dates are projections, but the scores are likely to come out within a week of the projected dates.**
