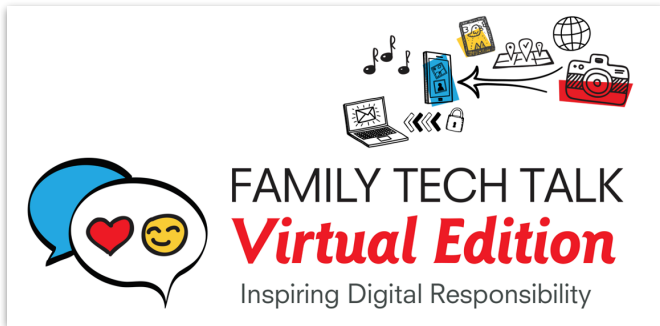

### About the virtual family tech talk presentation

Texting, gaming, Roblox, Minecraft, TikTok, YouTube. Technology is changing fast, and many of us are struggling to stay one step ahead of our kids and learn everything we can about being online. (Not an easy task when most of them know more about it than we do!)

**Join us for a virtual Family Tech Talk presentation hosted by an Internet safety expert from Trend Micro**, who will share the latest trends, give advice on how to help your child use the Internet responsibly, and answer parent questions in a Q&A session.
