





Changes in federal and state laws have directed schools to focus more on helping all children learn by addressing problems earlier and in general education.

These new laws emphasize the importance of providing high quality, scientifically-based instruction and interventions, and hold schools accountable for the adequate yearly progress of all students.

This new process provides academic and behavioral interventions to students, and then monitors their response to those interventions. As a result, this process is called Rtl, or Response to Intervention. Rtl replaces the previous Flex or problem-solving model and teams for Mendota schools.

RtI is a process designed to help schools focus on high quality interventions that ire matched to student needs and nonitored on a frequent basis. The nformation gained from an RtI process is 80-90% ised by school personnel and parents to adapt instruction and to make decisions regarding the student's educational program.

## Benefits of What Are the RtI?

for the academic skill areas, all students ire screened three times a year. If those lata indicate a problem area for a group, br an individual student, interventions are nitiated immediately.

As the interventions are taking plays the Intervention Teams monitor the process ising the same tools as in the screening. The results of the progress monitoring are charted and shared with staff and barents.

## What is the RtI Process?

The RtI process can be shown visually ising a three-tier intervention model as llustrated below:

<u>Tier 1</u>: Provides all students with whole group instruction using a core curriculum that is scientifically-based. The core curriculum should meet the needs of 80-90% of all students.

<u>Tier 2</u>: Provides supplemental interventions to small groups of students performing below benchmarks. These interventions are in addition to the core curriculum and, when combined with Tier 1, should meet the needs of an additional 5-10%.


