

Military History Course Description

Military History is an elective course that covers American military history starting with the American Revolution and goes through the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. Multiple delivery methods are used in the course combining Inquiry based learning opportunities with film study and primary source documentation. Students will learn about war tactics, strategies and weapons in order to gain a better understanding of the totality of warfare throughout the last 240 years. Students will also learn about the modern technology that is being developed in order to remove soldiers from the battlefields to preserve American lives. This elective course allows students independent study of topics of their personal interest.
