Crawford will begin offering two new dual credit classes beginning in the 2023 -2024 school year. One of the classes is English 1301. This class will be offered during the Spring semester and count for the second semester for English 4. Students must pass the English 1301 class to graduate. Students will stay in their English 4 classroom during their assigned English period, but will work on the English dual credit class. This class will not be included in GPA and will be online. The fall semester will concentrate on the literature TEKS, while the Spring will cover the writing TEKS. Students must pass the TSI writing or be exempt to be enrolled in the class.

The second class will be a dual credit Math class. Students will be required to have completed four math classes prior to enrolling in a dual credit math class. It is the students' responsibility to research their college degree plan and choose the specific math class they need. The math class will be housed in Mrs. Walker's room during calculus, but students will be working on their MCC math class during that time. This class will not be included in GPA and will be online. Students must pass the TSI math test, or be exempt from testing, and be advised by the MCC dual credit office before they are enrolled in the class.

Seniors choosing either of these options need to look at their college degree plan to see if these classes are required and will transfer. We advise students to speak to an advisor at their college to confirm required classes and transferability.
