

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING
OF THE
TYLER COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**

June 5, 2023

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Board members present were: President Linda Hoover, Scott Strode and Larry Thomas. Superintendent Shane Highley was also present. Vice President Katrina Byers was present by phone. Curtis Heintzman was not present.

Also present were: Tricia Feldmeier, Director of Human Resources; Emmalyn Olaru, Mihai Olaru, Alisha Tanley, Caleb Tanley, Sophiee Craven and Randy Rutherford with the Tyler Star News

On a motion made by Larry Thomas, seconded by Scott Strode, the Board went into Executive Session at 7:02 p.m. regarding Student Control #5-8-23 and Student Control #5-16-23 under Item 3, as per the School Laws of WV 6-9A-4, "The disciplining, suspension or expulsion of any student in any public school or public college or university, unless such student requests an open meeting." On a motion made by Katrina Byers, seconded by Curtis Heintzman with a 5-0 vote, the Board came out of Executive Session at 7:11 p.m.

On a motion made by Larry Thomas, seconded by Scott Strode with a 4-0 vote, the Board approved the Superintendent's recommendation of a 365-day expulsion for Student Control #5-8-23 and Student Control #5-16-23.

Mr. Highley updated the Board on the on-going projects in the county. The auditorium renovations are nearing completion. The HVAC project is moving along as expected.

The Board discussed the needed repairs to the road leading to Sistersville Elementary School.

Mr. Highley reported to the Board that he met with Sheriff Pratt to discuss the changes to the SRO contract. The Board would like to see the changes voted on at the next available board meeting. Vice President, Katrina Byers, mentioned that she would like to have a special meeting for the Board to discuss the contracts with the new Sheriff.

Mr. Highley updated the Board on the status of the test scores from the state-wide testing. He informed them that all scores are in but they are embargoed until fall.
