Parent University



Adopted Tax Rate

Last night, The WCISD Board of Trustees set the Wolfe City ISD Property Tax Rate of \$0.91440 for Maintenance and Operations and \$0.212900 for Interest and Sinking (I & S) for a total Tax Rate of \$1.127300 per \$100 valuation for 2022-2023. This tax rate is a reduction from last year's rate due to a required State Tax Compression of 2¢.

Facilities and Transportation updates

This past summer, WCISD has made several improvements to facilities. Major items included: Softball Concessions, AG Barn Extension and Remodel, HS Food Line, MS Gym Wall Pads, Portables at the HS, and several classroom remodels to create space for student growth. In 2021-2022, the ISD also added two new general school buses, one special education school bus, a maintenance van, and expanded the transportation lot covering.

This year we are already underway resurfacing the HS Baseball field with new irrigation and drainage. Sheila Gardner, Justin Vanhooser, and I met with an energy team to help support us in writing a grant for new electric buses. Submissions of the three grants are in and we are hopeful to be notified this fall that the buses will be fully funded through Federal and State.

The WCISD Board of Trustees approved the 2022-2023 SHAC Committee at last night's board meeting. The district has also selected the 2022-2023 District/Campus SBDMC.
