

Hispanic Heritage Month

Each year, Americans observe National Hispanic Heritage Month from **September 15 to October 15**, by celebrating the histories, cultures and contributions of American citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean and Central and South America.

My father, Javier Hugo Figueroa, is a native of Monterrey, Mexico. At 17, he became a US citizen and joined the Army, serving in Vietnam and Korea over his 12-year military service. In 2009, he was elected as a council member to the City of University Place and became the first naturalized citizen from Mexico to be elected in Washington State. In 2016, he ran as a Republican in lieutenant gubernatorial race in Washington State. After the election, he served as University Place's mayor in 2016-2017 and currently serves as the Mayor Pro-Tem.

In Wolfe City ISD, over 20% of our students and over 10% of our staff identify as Latino.
