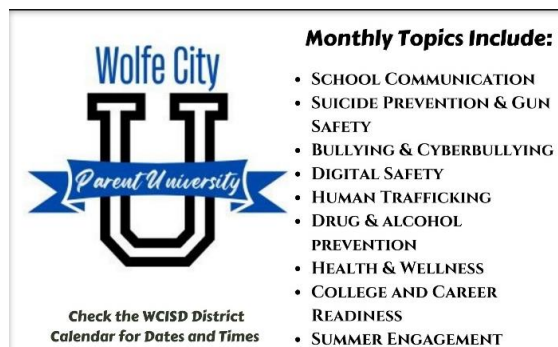

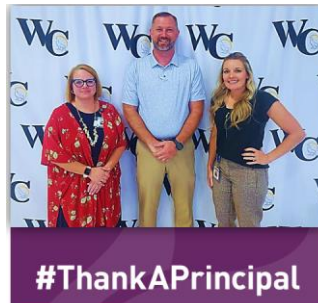


School Board Celebrations and Recognitions
