During May, vision screening will be offered to your child. Members of the Lions Club will use the Spot Vision Screener by Welch-Allyn. The Spot Screener takes an instant scan of your child's eyes to determine the presence of possible eye/vision problems. No physical contact is made with the student; he or she simply looks at blinking lights on the screener for a second or two. Visit www.welchallyn.com on-line to learn more about this efficient Spot Vision Screener. Your child may be asked to wear a face mask briefly during the screening process.

If a child wears glasses or contact lenses they should be worn during screening. You'll be notified by the school nurse if referral to an eye doctor is indicated. Results obtained are considered a preliminary predictor and do not constitute a diagnosis of vision problems.

The Lions Club will be at Centre School Thursday, May 26th to screen Pre-School and Grade 1 students, and students referred by the nurse.
