Friday, May 20th, 10 AM-12 PM

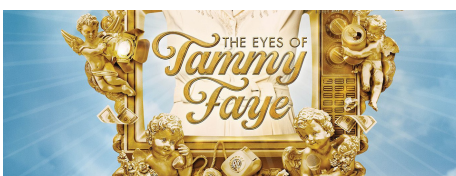
Come visit and feed a variety of animals including chickens and goats from Legacy Lane Farm in Stratham! Registration for a 30 minute time slot is required.
