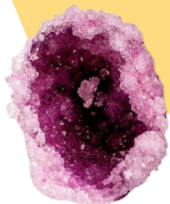
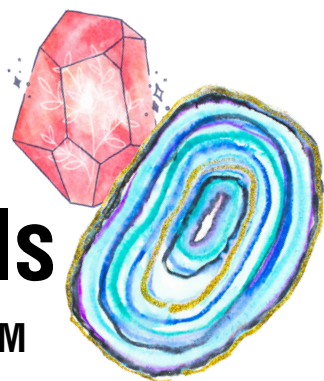


# KIDS EVENT
