## Visitors to Grassy Creek


Parents are always welcome to visit our school and are encouraged to do so. For everyone's safety, all visitors must sign in at the office to obtain a visitor sticker or badge. Please be prepared to submit your ID to office staff upon check-in. If you plan to visit a classroom, please call a day before to make sure it's a good time for a visit. For the safety of all students, special guidelines are enforced for lunchtime visitors. These guidelines include:

1. Any adult who is on a child's emergency card will be allowed to eat lunch with that child.
2. If an adult is not on a child's emergency card, they may eat lunch with a child if they have been given written permission by the parent or guardian.
3. All lunch visitors should be prepared to show picture ID in the front office.
4. Lunch visitors and the child they are visiting will sit at a separate table if space allows in the cafeteria.
5. Visitors may not stay for recess.
