RE: Weekend Survival Kits (WSK) – Participation Form

Dear Parent or Guardian,

We are happy to announce that the Weekend Survival Kits Backpack Program will be provided at your child's school this year.

Weekend Survival Kits are a supplemental food program that feed children over the weekend, when food can be uncertain. A typical kit will contain approximately two weekends worth of food servings, that are discretely sent home with students every other Thursday each month.

A Weekend Survival Kit's contents change, but typically include 2 boxes of mac & cheese, 2 granola bars, 1 can of vegetables, 1 jar of peanut butter/protein, 2 cans of fruit, 4 oatmeal packets, 1 can of soup, and 1 can of Spaghetti Rings purchased through the Greater Lansing Food Bank. The kits are FREE to Elementary children that are eligible, because they currently qualify and participate in the Free or Reduced Price School Meal Program through the Michigan Department of Education (MDE). Again, know that there is no cost to participate in the WSK program. If you would like your child to participate, please sign this form and return it to the school office.
