Student No. 23958 shall be expelled from the schools of the District for the remainder of the spring semester of the 2017-2018 school year and fall semester of the 2018-2019 school year. It is further recommended that student 23958 may apply to re-enroll at Yolo Middle School at the beginning of the spring semester of 2018-2019 school year.
