Dear Parent/Guardian,

Home Street Middle School will begin teaching RIGHTS, RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY (3RS), a human sexuality curriculum, to all 6th grade students on April 24-28. The Inyo County Office of Education selected this curriculum due to its age-appropriate, medical-based content and its information about healthy relationships and promoting abstinence as the healthiest choice to prevent pregnancy and disease transmission. Rights, Respect, Responsibility (3Rs) is a comprehensive sexual health curriculum that complies with CA Healthy Youth Act requirements and National Sexuality Education Standards. The 3Rs lessons were authored by Advocates for Youth, who is funded and supported by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and who collaborates with the California Department of Education to implement medically accurate sexuality education state-wide. This curriculum is being utilized at all middle and high schools in Inyo County.

Participating in this human sexuality curriculum may increase students' ability to communicate their personal boundaries, and choose healthy relationships to prevent dating violence. Participation may also reduce their risk of getting pregnant or getting someone else pregnant and having a sexually transmitted infection.

Home Street Middle School has an "opt-out" policy where the parent/guardian must sign if you do not agree for your child to take part in the curriculum.
