- Develop building/department communication teams to help increase communication efforts
- Increase collaboration with local press to share special news
- Enhance the quarterly district newsletter with new features
 - Create student spotlights
 - Create alumni spotlights
- Increase signage around District (exterior & interior)
- Develop character traits that will be a focus each month K-12
- Implement quarterly "Pep Rally" type activities in each building (including academics, character, athletics, etc.)
- Increase social media presence at all buildings and in athletic department

- Partner with BCIU to Audit K-12 Math Department (Curriculum, Resources, Instruction, etc.)
- Bolster new teacher induction program (from 1 to 2-year program)
- Implement K-12 support models for all students - MTSS Model (w/ Universal Screeners for ELA & Math)
- Increase Secondary Instructional Time (by extending the length of day)
- Implement Intervention Block in HS Schedule
- Revise ES Schedule to Better Support Intervention Model
- Implement Standardized Gradebook (Weighted = 60% Summative / 40% Formative)
- Implement Standardized Retesting Practice
- Implement Standardized Late Work Policy
- Implement Standardized Extra Credit Policy
- Implement Standardized Homework Grading Practice
- Evaluate Homework Expectations
- Institute a BHASD PreK program and develop a collaboration with the existing BCIU PreK program

- Provide additional supports for students with mental health needs
- Maximize equitable experiences for all students
- Utilize grant dollars to purchase exterior door sensors and additional security cameras to ensure perimeter security
- Increase guidance/social work support

- Increase connections between HS, MS, & youth athletic programs
- Develop and promote athletic opportunities from youth programs to HS
- Strengthen partnership with booster clubs
- Encourage multi-sport/activity athletes
- Develop partnerships with surrounding colleges (or higher-level connections) to create opportunities for serious athletes
- Develop open gym times for beginner athletes
- Investigate the impact cost has on engagement (to play, as well as attend events - for athletics & extracurricular/clubs)
- Investigate consistency of payment required for attendance for different sports
- Increase connections between HS, MS, IS, & ES in area of music, art, STEM, etc.
- Facilitate scheduling accessibility for building, community, music, and athletic events
- Support the development of an Educational Foundation
