*Welcome to GT! The adventure begins!*

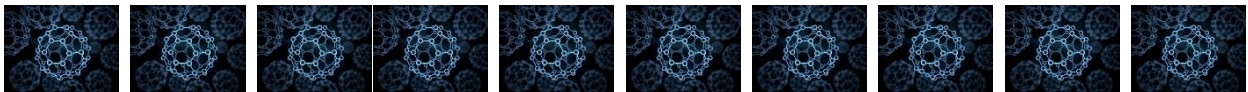
