



Process for Development of School/Family/Student Compact

The School/Family/Student compact is a written agreement between teachers and parents and provides an opportunity to create new partnerships in our school community. The document explains what families and schools can do to help children reach high academic standards of excellence. The compact serves as a clear reminder of all stakeholders' responsibility to take action at school and at home so that children can attain the state's academic achievement standards. It is a written commitment indicating how all members of a school community – parents, teachers, principals, students, and concerned community members – agree to share responsibility for improved student achievement.
