

## MARION F/S MEET 4/25

The freshmen and sophomores traveled to Marion for a meet against Carbondale, Carterville, Mt. Vernon, Harrisburg, and host Marion. The Orphans had multiple first place performances. Keaton Morgan jumped to one of those with a 19' 6.5" Long Jump mark and setting a personal record. Arion Hill won the 110 H Hurdles with a time of 16.05. Leonard Bratton had a big day setting personal records and winning two events Triple Jump (41' 11.75") and High Jump (6'0"). Leonard is now within reach of two IHSA State qualifying standard in those two events. Reed Ashford finished 2nd in High Jump (5' 10"). Reed was close to clearing the six foot height yesterday as well, and is capable of making the 6' 1" qualifying standard. Gavin Berry placed 4th in Shot Put (36' 4.75") and teammate Kasanova Poore placed 6th in Shot Put (34' 6.25"). Jacob Dahlquist earned a 5th place finish in the 1600 M Run (5:02.99). That was a personal record for Jake as he is looking to break five minutes in the mile. The 4x400 team of Keaton Morgan, Arion Hill, Leonard Bratton, and Luke Mayer finished 4th place with a time of 3:51.33. The young tracksters will have one more meet when they travel to Marion for the F/S South 7 Conference meet.
