Academic Programming

Evaluate and Revise Online Academic Programs

- Initiate Summer School offering via Indiana Online Academy (IOA) May 2023
- Partially utilize IOA for credit recovery and first run course offerings August 2023
- Fully implement IOA as primary credit recovery and first run course offerings August 2024
- Investigate the rationale and sustainability for utilization of a certificated instructional employee in the Academic Learning Lab – August 2023

Create a Civil Construction Graduation Pathway for TCHS

- Implement a two-hour block pathway for the 2023-24 school year
- Implement a four-hour block pathway for the 2024-25 school year

Investigate the student interest level in a dual credit Speech course at TCHS
