FROM THE DESK OF THE SUPERINTENDENT....

The start of the 2018-19 school year brings with it back-to-school excitement, lasting memories to be made, and friendships to be found and built upon. It also brings a renewed focus on school safety, as we know that our number one goal is to keep all students and staff safe. In Bangor Township Schools, from the school board and the employees, we are putting new safety measures in place in order to be ready for the return of students and staff.

One of the first safety measures that we are implementing this year is the addition of a school resource officer for the district. We are partnering with the Bay County Sheriff's Office to house an officer on the campus of John Glenn High School and Christa McAuliffe Middle School. However, the officer will be servicing all buildings in Bangor - educating students and staff on school and internet safety, being a resource for all safety issues, as well as being a presence at our buildings and at events. With all of the safety concerns around the nation, particularly in schools, the addition of a school resource officer is a must.

Another safety measure we are putting in place deals with the hardening of our entrances and location of the offices at our buildings. The State of Michigan recently approved \$25 million dollars in grants for school districts to apply for in order to address safety issues in their districts. We will be applying for this grant in hopes of getting state dollars to help us better locate the offices in our buildings and to redesign how the public accesses our buildings and offices.

A third safety measure we will be implementing this year is a new visitor system at all our buildings. We piloted the system last year at Bangor Lincoln, and it worked very well. This is something we must do in order to control the access the public has to our schools and our students. Be patient, as this will be a new initiative, but the payoff is a much safer system that will better protect kids, while controlling who is entering our buildings.

Lastly, our entire staff will receive another round of school safety training when they return to work this year. The training will be followed by an active shooter simulation in the building by The Michigan State Police SWAT team. The training and simulation are another much needed step in our continued focus on being better prepared if a safety issues arises.

Please know that we are committed to keeping all students and staff safe, and we are allocating the necessary time, training, and resources toward this commitment. Through our partnerships with the Michigan State Police and the Bay County Sheriff's Department, we have been able to focus our efforts toward hardening our buildings and better protecting students and staff. We take pride in our district and we strive to provide the best experience to all our students and families, and it all starts with keeping everyone safe. If you should ever have a question, concern, or idea regarding school safety, please do not hesitate to reach out to me.






A huge congratulations to

TITLE I PROGRAM

Dear Parent or Guardian of Elementary School Students:

Your child currently attends a school that receives funds from the Title I, Part A Program. Title I, Part A is a federal supplemental program designed to help children reach high academic standards. In receiving funds from the program the district has a requirement to inform you, as parents of children attending a Title I school, of information available to you regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher(s). Information will be provided to you upon request and in a timely manner of the following:

- Whether your child's teacher has met Michigan qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- Whether your child's teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which Michigan qualification or licensing have been waived.
- The baccalaureate degree major of your child's teacher and any other graduate cert-teacher and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- Whether your child is provided services by para-professionals and, if so, their qualifications.

You may request additional information on the level of achievement of your child in each of Michigan's assessments.

Michigan uses the Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP) to determine levels of achievement.

You will also receive timely notice if your child is, for whatever reason, assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks, by a teacher who is not highly qualified. A highly qualified would be defined as a teacher that meets Michigan's qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level or subject area in which the teacher is providing instruction.

PUBLIC NOTICE

ANNUAL ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT

This notice is to inform you that a Management Plan has been completed and submitted to the State of Michigan for approval and is currently available for your review at the Edison Administrative Building.

For every school building where asbestos has been found, there is a Management Plan containing information regarding location, condition, and a plan for monitoring and maintaining the asbestos containing materials.

At least once a year the District will inform you in a similar manner about asbestos activities that are planned or in progress. The following asbestos activities are currently planned for the District:

Re-Inspection

Re-inspection of all District buildings is required by law every three years.

Periodic Surveillance -

Once every six months, asbestos containing materials must be visually inspected for changes in condition. The results of these inspections are also documented in the Management Plan.

Response Actions -

The regularly scheduled inspections permit the School District to immediately repair any damaged asbestos containing materials and maintain a safe environment for all students and employees.

In the event that there is a need to remove any asbestos containing materials, the District will contract an experienced and qualified asbestos abatement contract and a professional consultant to independently monitor the activities to ensure the safety of the occupants. Records of the response action and a report of the monitoring are on file at the Edison Administrative Building.

INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Bangor Township School District utilized an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach to control pests. IPM is a pes management system that utilizes all suitable techniques in a total pest management system with the intent of preventing pests from reaching unacceptable levels or to reduce an existing population to an Acceptable level. Pest Management techniques emphasize pest exclusion and biological controls.

However, as with most pest control programs, chemical controls, may also be utilized.

You will receive advance notice of any pesticide application made to the schools grounds or buildings through several methods. Posting of an upcoming pesticide application will be done at the website (www.bangorschools.org) as well as give your child or student information to provide to you. You also have the right to be informed prior to the pesticide application by first class mail, if you so request. In certain emergencies, such as an infestation of stinging insects, pesticides may be applied without prior notice to prevent injury to students, but you will be notified following any such application.
