



Cami plans to attend Lake Land College after graduation. Congratulations Cami!








#### **Cheyenne Fleshner**

#### **Taylor Sims**



After Graduation Madison plans to attend Lake Land College to study Art. Congratulations Madison!










#### **Natalee Hunter**
