Course Description:

This course is a comprehensive introduction to broadcasting and journalism, covering how news is produced and delivered, how news organizations work, and how audiences react to and interact with the news media. The course will offer basic instruction in the fundamental practices of journalism; reporting, writing, editing and publishing. Students will develop these basic skills through the production of video projects, weekly news broadcasts, and *The T-Bird Times*, a weekly news publication.

Class Expectations:

- Students are expected to be on time to class and must be in complete uniform when they enter the classroom.
