ISTEP+ 10 Mathematics is a process and not an event. Students are scored on both content knowledge and process knowledge used to support answers. Successful schools have designed a year-long plan for spring testing to ensure students are ready to meet the challenge.

This workshop is designed to help schools, teachers, and students to be better prepared for the spring 2018-19 math ISTEP+ assessment.

### *Workshop Objectives Addressed:*

>Identify Grade 10 Math “Big Ideas”

- Identify instructional strategies for surface, deep and transfer learning
- Understand depth of knowledge
- Learn how to implement mathematical discourse to reach deep understanding and knowledge retention
- Learn appropriate kinds of assessment questions

>Use ISTEP+ Data from 2018 to make decisions for 2019
