Procedures & Expectations

We, as teachers, are hoping that by doing this through all grades, we will help make your child's school life as pleasant and successful as possible. Please read over these procedures and expectations and help me to make your child into all that God has planned for them.

Classroom Expectations:

- Listen when teacher or classmates are speaking.
- Obey the teacher.
- Raise your hand to speak.
- Use your best manners. (Yes/No, Mam,)
- Stay in your chair.
- When sitting on floor, have legs crossed and hands in lap.
- Hands are for loving, not hitting.

Consequences if expectations are not met:

- First time- verbal warning
- Second time- Apple is moved from tree to trunk, (Conduct moves from A to B and no sticker at end of day)
- Third time- Apple is moved from trunk to grass. Loss of playtime. (Conduct moves from B to C) Note will be sent home or parent contacted.

Positive Reinforcement:

- Apple stays on tree- Sticker at end of day
- Sticker everyday in a week- Pull a coupon for special privilege
- Secret Student- Daily, I will pull one name anonymously. If that student follows our class procedures for the day, they will receive a star coupon at dismissal time.

Procedures:

- Hall- use the "Flip & Zip" hall procedure. No talking is allowed when we are lined up and moving from one area of the school to another. This respects the other students who are learning in nearby areas. Use walking feet.
- Lunch- use good manners. Sit in your chair, not on knees. Quiet lunch for 10 minutes then talk in a quiet voice.
- Attention Getter- I will raise my hand with a "GIVE ME FIVE" signal to gain their attention. This indicates:
1- Eyes On teacher. 2- Mouth closed. 3- Ears open.
4- Hands still. 5- Wiggles gone.
I will also use a clapping pattern or chimes to get their attention when needed.
