Welcome to Spanish II Class with Mrs. Reynolds!! I'm looking forward to working with you this year and continue your learning process of the Spanish language. Please read through the course description, materials, grading and policies.

## ➤ Course description

In Spanish II we will continue working with the skills learned in Spanish I: reading, writing, listening, speaking and culture. Different themes and vocabulary will be introduced such as: Food, Daily routines, feelings, garments, numbers, holidays, hopes and wishes. Grammar will be more advanced; students will learn how to use other tenses and structure more complex sentences. They will be able to describe nouns and actions with more detail in a fluid manner. They will be able to write and speak in the present, and past tenses. They will also learn infinitive and reflexive verbs and be able to write/speak about a typical day. The majority of the conversational dynamics in this class will be conducted in Spanish.
