## COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Board recognizes that education is a life-long process, and that it has an educational responsibility to the entire community. Accordingly, community education courses will be provided to meet the needs of adults and out-of-school youth for basic education, general and academic education, occupational education, and development of special interests in various arts, crafts, and recreation.

The community education program will be supported by a combination of district funds, state and federal aid, and fees. Tuition charges will be as determined by the Community Education Advisory Board.

The superintendent will serve on the Community Education Advisory Board, and the day-to-day operations will be overseen by the Community Education Director.
