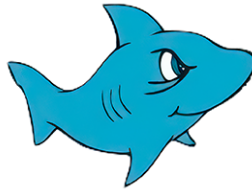
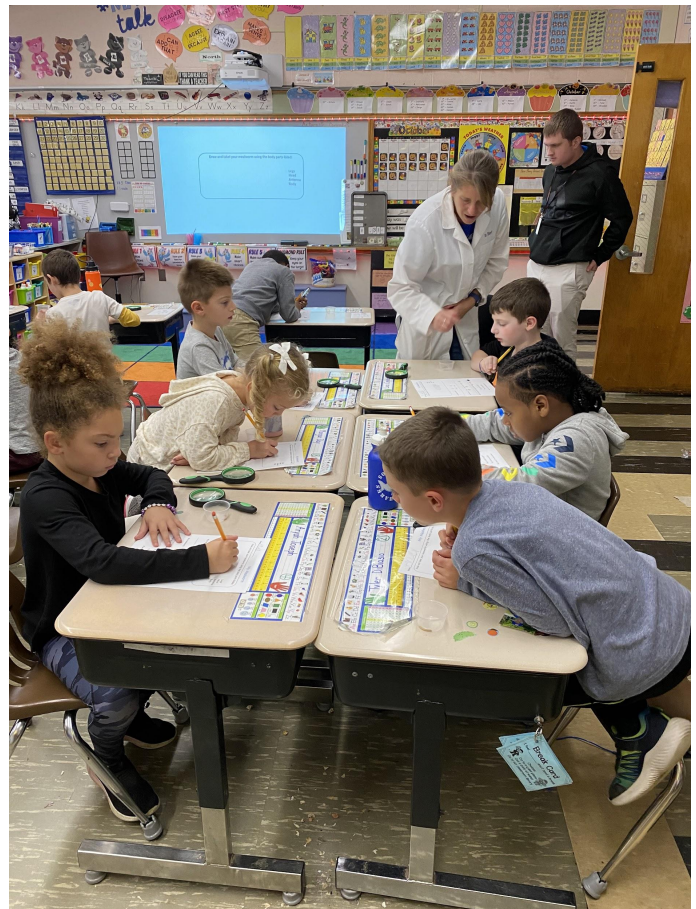

## Halloween Celebration

The plan for this year is:

- Students may wear their Halloween Costumes to school on Monday, October 31st, 2022
- Students who do not observe Halloween can participate by wearing black & orange for Stoughton Pride, South School Spirit Gear, or their pajamas!
- Students must come to school with an additional set of clothes on the day that they will be wearing their costumes.

### **Rules for Costumes:**

- Students are not allowed to bring costume-related weapons
- Students are not allowed to wear Halloween masks
- Students' costumes cannot be overly gory, or, scary
- Students should be able to get in and out of their costume for bathroom usage as teachers are not able to assist in changing students into or out of costumes during the day
- *If a student's costume becomes too distracting, they may be told to change into the other set of clothes that they brought with them.*
