Call to Order:

A meeting of the Hardee Junior High School Advisory Council was held in the room 305 on October 17, 2022. Principal, Dr. Sheryl Mosley called the meeting to order at 3:45pm.

Minutes: First meeting of the 2022-2023 school year, no minutes were shared.

Old Business: First meeting of the 2022-2023 school year, no minutes were shared.

New Business:

1. **Welcome:** Dr. Mosley opened the meeting by introducing the SAC members and gave a brief overview of the purpose of the HJH SAC committee.
2. Each member was given a copy of the HJH SAC by-laws to review. Dr. Mosley asked if anyone had additional questions about the SAC by-laws. No questions were asked.
3. **SAC Officer Elections:** Did not hold election due to low member attendance.
4. **School Improvement Plan:** The School Improvement Plan (SIP) for 2022-2023 has been sent to the school board for approval. This year the focus is to increase reading and math scores. Additional information will be shared once we receive approval from the HCSB.
5. **Controlled Open Enrollment Policy:** Waivers open in May for all schools in Hardee County. HJH is the only middle school in the district so waivers are primarily utilized in the elementary schools. Parents are responsible for transportation if the student is not in our district.
6. **School-Parent-Student Compact 2022-2023:** Dr. Mosley asked the committee to look over the compact and make any suggestions. The compact lists expectations during the school year for teachers, support staff, administrators, students and parents. No suggestions were made to add or delete anything. Mrs. Johnson motioned to approve compact and Mrs. Calvillo second it.
7. **Parent and Family Engagement Plan:** Dr. Mosley shared that HJH will be hosting our annual Title I and Science Night On Thursday, October 20, 2022. Core teachers will be set up in the gym to answer any curriculum questions and class expectations. Our Title I information will be presented in the auditorium followed by the science department. Mrs. McGuckin and Mrs. Ford will go over science fair expectations and answer questions. The Activities' committee and HJH Student Council have teamed up to sponsor some goody baskets for our parents. These baskets will be raffled off to four lucky parents who attend Parent Night.
8. **Federal Programs 2022-2023 Activities:** Dr. Mosley provided a handout with the programs' activities paid for by Title1-Title IX monies. The handout lists resources and itemized programs used by the Hardee County district and HJH. Dr. Mosley asked the committee if they had any questions. No questions were asked. She informed the committee that after school would begin in the upcoming weeks. This year HJH will be providing some enrichment programs such as Odyssey of the Minds headed by Mrs. Smith. There will also be some Stem projects and extra support for our Algebra students. Our normal after school program will also be offered.
9. **Title I 6150:** (Parent Involvement Funds) - Dr. Mosley explained that these funds are used to promote parent involvement and encourage student achievement. These funds will support parent nights, purchase materials such as paper for parent newsletters. They can also be used for Science Fair awards.
