

What Not To Wear



No see-through or fishnet tops



No short shorts or skirts



No off-the-shoulder tops



No spaghetti straps or revealing tops



No short shirts or bare midriffs



No sandals or flip-flops that are not secured to the ankle, including Crocs and Birkenstocks



No muscle shirts



No sagging pants or shorts



No wearing hats, hoods, beanies, bandannas or sunglasses indoors or in class



No references to the use of drugs, alcohol, guns, weapons or profane, vulgar and/or discriminatory words.

Dress Code

Good appearance, good attitudes, and good grooming add to the effectiveness of a student in school and are very conducive to a good learning environment. Students are expected to attend school in neat, clean, appropriate clothing and their bodies covered. The following rules are intended to define appropriate student attire and personal grooming. Parents are expected to enforce the dress code standards before the children leave for school each morning. This will allow the school to fully concentrate on the educational development of every child in the district.

- No above the knee see through leggings.
- No sagging pants/shorts.
- No mid-sections showing or exposed when arms are raised.
- No spaghetti straps or muscle t-shirts.
- No undergarments showing.
- No pajamas.
- No profane, vulgar, discriminatory words, pictures or references to use of drugs, alcohol, guns, or weapons on clothing.
- No low cut/backless dresses or shirts.
- No flip flops/slippers/backless shoes or Heelys.
- No hats, hoods, beanies, bandanas, or sunglasses inside any building, classroom or hallway.
- No writing on bodies or clothes.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be an appropriate length.
