8 Tips for Implementing a Strategic Plan

- 1) Be clear on where we are going.
- 2) Take a simplified approach that creates clarity.
- 3) Establish strategic direction through multi-year planning.
- 4) Constantly assess the environment.
- 5) Be flexible, iterate, and adapt.
- 6) Rely on data and metrics for objective progress points.
- 7) Work effectively across teams.
- 8) Embrace learning from failure.


