## Immunization Requirements for All Students K-12

All students must be up-to-date with their immunizations in order to start school in August 2018. Please take the time to read this and follow the proper steps to making sure your child is able to attend school this fall.

Below is a list of ALL the REQUIRED immunizations:

- 1) TWO Meningococcal (MCV4)- One dose required for 7<sup>th</sup> grade and second dose at age 16 years as of Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. If the first dose of Meningococcal vaccine is administered at age 16 or older, no second dose is required.
- 2) ALL Students in K-12 will be required to have TWO Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccinations, unless documentation by a medical provider (MD, APRN, or PA only) is provided. No parent notes are accepted. If they do not have this documentation they must have the shot.
- 3) One dose Tdap required on ALL students who are 11 years old by September 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- 4) ONE Hepatitis A required on ALL kindergarten students. (Must be given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday.)
- 5) ALL students K-12 are required to have:
  - -FOUR DTaP and THREE Polio (Last dose must be given on or after  $4^{th}$  birthday.)
  - -THREE Hep B
  - -TWO MMR
