Eligibility Requirements

1	American Legion Auxiliary, Green Mountain Unit #1	Awarded to a High School Senior who is a son, daughter, grandchild or great grandchild or stepchild of a current or deceased member of American Legion Auxiliary Unit 1.
2	American Legion – Simon Godfrey & Matthew W. Brigham Scholarships (One application for 2 scholarships!)	Students must exhibit financial need, and must be the child or grandchild of a veteran, transcript needed.
3	Andy “A-DOG” Williams Scholarship	Students will exhibit a passion for creating music, visual art, videography/photography, or dance; must demonstrate financial need.
4	Barbara Clark Memorial Scholarship	Students will demonstrate the following attributes: determination, loyalty, and an unyielding competitive spirit, active in extracurricular activities, academics
5	Billy Howrigan Scholarship	Open to Students pursuing higher education, including vocational and trade schools. Preference to residents of Fairfield and to students pursuing studies/degrees related to agriculture or forestry.
6	Bob Bliss Dollars for Scholars	Students will demonstrate the following characteristics: hard working, academics, sports and extracurricular activities, community and church service.
7	Brandon Michael Stephenson Scholarship	Students will demonstrate the following characteristics: accepting, dedicated, and involved, supportive of peers and others.
8	Brandon Gleason Scholarship	Students will demonstrate the following qualities: leadership on and off the sports courts/fields, a friend to all, loving, kind, and generous.
9	Catholic Daughters of America	Students who apply must be a child or grandchild of a member of the Catholic Daughters of America Association.
10	Chauncy Warner	This scholarship is open to students who will be pursuing any of the following: associate degree, bachelor's degree, technology program, or other advanced training.
11	Christi Kelli Corrigan Scholarship	Students who apply must be a Comet Hockey Team member and should demonstrate the following qualities: leadership, school spirit, academic strength, love for the arts, athletics, and show they are a student who has a kind and giving heart who embraces life and all the possibilities it has to offer.
12	Connor “Cheech” Roberts Memorial Scholarship	The student must demonstrate the following qualities: passion for life, dedication and loyalty to family and friends, multi-sport athlete, pursuing a higher education. Transcript and letters of recommendation, written responses.
13	Ed Brehaut Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship is for student athletes.
14	Fairfield Scholarships	Students must be a Fairfield resident, school activities, academic achievement, financial need, transcript, letters of recommendation needed.

15	Georgia Conservation Commission Scholarship	Students must be a Georgia resident and pursuing a major in conservation, environmental studies or ecology.
16	Georgia Fire & Rescue Art Carrol Scholarship	Students who apply must be a current resident of the town of Georgia, Vermont and pursuing education towards emergency medical services (EMS) or a healthcare-related field.
17	Harold J. Howrigan, Sr. Scholarship (at least 2 scholarships awarded)	Students who apply must demonstrate the following qualities: strong academics, and leadership skills.
18	Jamie P. Jackson Memorial	This scholarship is for male athletes who have been involved in four years of extracurricular activities.
19	Jodi Flanagan Memorial	This scholarship is for a female/male student who participated in any sport while attending BFA.
20	John Finn Memorial Scholarship	Students who apply must demonstrate the following qualities: Strong academic performance, and community involvement,
21	Kemper Peabody	Students who apply must demonstrate commitment to their own self-improvement, responsibility for their community, and financial need.
22	Kyndle Mongeon Memorial Scholarship	Students who apply must demonstrate the following qualities: Band, Athletics, Drama, Leadership, School Spirit. Preference is given to National Honor Society inductees.
23	Maida F. Townsend Scholarship	Students who apply must have parent who belongs to the NEA.
24	Margaret J. Cutting Scholarship Fund	Students who apply must live in Bakersfield or Franklin County and have a good academic record, and financial need.
25	Maria Boissoneault Memorial Scholarship	Students who apply must demonstrate financial need.
26	Martin H. Wennar MD Health Education Scholarship	Students who apply must demonstrate community service and plan to enter a health field, other than pre-medicine.
27	Megan Patenaude Memorial Scholarship	Students who apply must demonstrate the following: love of life, helping others, career in social services, athletics, and academics.
28	St. Albans High School – BFA Alumni Irrevocable Scholarship Trust Fund	Students who apply must demonstrate: financial need, and extracurricular activities.
29	Wendy Ann Chagnon Memorial Scholarship	Students who apply must have participated in the BFA Band and have taken Business classes.
30	Colby Patee	Franklin County senior who will be enrolling in a trade/technical school.
