

## To Parents/Guardians, Teachers, Students, & Employee Organizations:

In accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), parents and guardians, teachers, children, and employees of the Willingboro Board of Education must be notified annually of the district's activities regarding asbestos found in the schools.

Under the AHERA Regulation it was required that all educational facilities be inspected for asbestos containing materials. Subsequent Tri-Annual Re-inspections and periodic surveillances (every six months) are required to update and maintain the Asbestos Management plan. The last surveillance was conducted in March 2018, with the last 3-Year Re-Inspection having been conducted in September 2016.

AHERA Consultants, Inc. will be conducting the next periodic surveillance in September 2018. Following the surveillance, reports will be assimilated into the Management Plan and be available inside the main office of each school building as well as the Willingboro Board of Education Administrative Offices. They will be available for review during normal operating hours.

AHERA Consultants, Inc. has also conducted O&M activities in various facilities as needed. AHERA Consultants, Inc. will work closely with the Supervisor of Facilities, Mr. Orlando Chandler, who will keep us informed of any potential asbestos issues within the district.
