2452- COMMUNITY EDUCATION

The Board of Education may establish and maintain a program of community education and shall utilize its school facilities for accomplishing the legitimate educational purposes of serving the vocational, and cultural interests of the community.

The Board may also maintain a program of instruction in English language and in government and laws for the benefit of foreign-born residents of the district.

The Superintendent shall utilize appropriate staff members, invite the participation of representatives of the community, cooperate with local organizations and agencies, and assess the needs and resources of the community to develop a program of community education and present that program to the Board for its approval. The Superintendent is directed to seek out and utilize such sources of revenue as may be appropriate for the financial support of the community education program.

The program of community education shall be maintained at no cost to the Board. Persons who participate shall be charged tuition pursuant to law and shall provide all supplies necessary to the accomplishment of their program. The amount of the tuition payment will depend on funding sources determined on an annual basis.

No credit toward graduation shall be awarded for participation in the community education program.
