

#### Some beginning of the year reminders:

- Update contact numbers and please be sure we have the ability to leave a message if needed
- Have a plan ready in case a child needs to go home before normal dismissal time
- The district's current fever policy is that children will be dismissed from school for a fever of 100.4F or greater. Any child who has a fever (home or school) must be out of school <u>until 24hrs have passed without a fever</u> without the use of fever-reducing medications.
- Please notify the school with any student's positive Covid testing so we can discuss isolation and quarantine recommendations.
