

Notes from Nurse Amanda



- April marks Autism Acceptance Month, which is a month-long celebration of Autism and Autistic people, as well as those who support the Autistic community!
- Autism is the fastest-growing developmental disability in the United States, with one

in 36 children receiving a diagnosis, according to today's newly released report from the Centers for Disease Control

- In addition to the 5.8 million Autistic adults, this
 prevalence means that Autism likely touches a vast
 majority of Americans either through relationships or
 direct experience, and the support needs across the
 Autism spectrum are vastly different
- This is a great reminder that we can and should see the individual, not a diagnosis, and work together to advocate for the unique services and supports that help each person live fully

Reminders:

- Consent forms for school medical services are required for children to receive any type of medical treatment from school personnel.
- Children with any fever greater than 100.4F must be home from school and remain home until fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.
- Please notify the school nurse if your child or someone in their household has been diagnosed with Covid.


